eDeveloper for iSeries - New products

eDeveloper 9.4 offers new add-ons making integration to iSeries much easier.

The **Legacy Connector** application enables any eDeveloper programmer to quickly and easily integrate iSeries (5250) terminal interfaced application with eDeveloper's Windows/Web applications.

The **eDeveloper Navigator** is an out-of-the-box application that can be used immediately by iSeries system administrators and operators to access system services such as Active Jobs, Spooled File, IFS Objects, and System Values. In addition, the eDeveloper Navigator enables system administrators to send email, execute a CL command, and check the system status, including memory and disk usage.

eDeveloper for iSeries SQL Client

eDeveloper 9.4 SP6 includes the iSeries SQL client 9.4 SP6-0.9 release for eDeveloper. You can read more about this in the README400sql.htm file.

eDeveloper for iSeries ISAM Client

eDeveloper 9.4 SP6 includes the updated version of the iSeries ISAM client 9.4 SP6-0.4 for eDeveloper. You can read more about this in the <u>README400.htm</u> file.

eDeveloper for iSeries DBCS Client

The iSeries DBCS Client installation lets you install a special iSeries client for the Double-byte character set (DBCS) version of an operating system. You can read more about this in the README400.htm file.

▲ Fixed Problems

Table Control – Alternating Color (QCR #299207)

Controls in a table that had a dynamic color value were not correctly displayed if the table was set with alternating row colors.

Shared Values (QCR #493039)

The SharedValSet function failed to set a shared value if the value name was dynamically set and the content of the value was a rich text.

Print Preview - Memory Consumption (QCR # 692886)

Redundant memory consumption was observed when opening the print preview module.

MySQL Via ODBC - Wrong Date & Time Values (QCR # 701720)

Wrong date and time values were fetched from MySQL tables via ODBC gateway.

Application Server – Component Program's Parameters (QCR # 704236)

Wrong values were received in component program's parameters when such a program was executed by a request to a background server engine.

Error Handling – Directives (QCR #757524)

The Skip directive of an error handler was ignored if the task had linked records with Locate definition for a non-existing record.

Browser Client - Dynamic Picture Value (QCR # 761101)

In a .NET based browser client application, the dynamic picture of an edit field in the first line of a table column affected all consecutive edit fields in the same column.

Browser Client - Memory Consumption (QCR #771020)

Redundant memory consumption was observed on running a .NET based browser client application.

Deferred Transaction – Performance (QCR # 996363)

The performance of fetching records in a deferred transaction has been notably improved.
